	(3) Activities to make the ECHONET Lite AIF specifications into a international specification standard • Since 2017, the ECHONET Consortium has been working to make the ECHONET Lite AIF specifications (between home air conditioners and controllers) an international standard in collaboration with the Kanagawa Institute of Technology and with the help of METI.
	•The submitted Committee Draft (CD) was approved at the ISO/IEC JTC1 SC25 international conference held in Nagasaki September 23–27 of this year, and transferring the Committee / Draft for Vote (CDV) for the next stage has also been approved.
Planning and Steering Committee	(1) Holding of the Eleventh Forum
	As reported in the topics, the Eleventh Forum was held at the Large Hall, Seavans S Building 1F on July 11. The forum was successful with 109 total participants.
	Besides a special lecture, 2019 business plans of various committees, technical talks by seven member companies, and technical exhibitions by eight companies were presented to facilitate communication between member companies.
	(2) Activities to make the ECHONET Lite AIF specifications into a international specification standard As reported in the topics,the submitted Committee Draft (CD) was approved at the ISO/IEC JTC1 SC25 international conference, and transferring the Committee / Draft for Vote (CDV) for the next stage has also been approved. In parallel with WG1 deliberations, the ECHONET Consortium demonstrated a multi-vendor demonstration that included two air conditioners and three controllers. This demonstration allowed us to appeal to SC25 members for high interoperability under the ECHONET Lite AIF specification.
Technical Committee	(1) Detailed Requirements for Device Objects • Completed the English translation of the APPENDIX Detailed Requirements for ECHONET Device objects (Release L). Started publishing for the general public.
	(2) ECHONET Lite Web API • Started member review of the ECHONET Lite Web API Appendix Version 1.10 Draft with an increased number of supported devices in the Device Description.
	(3) Holding of Plug Fest events On August 29–30, the first Plug Fest was held at the HEMS Test Center, Kanagawa Institute of Technology. This time, members of five teams from five companies participated.

IFA exhibition (September 6-11, 2019) Messe Berlin

- The ECHONET Consortium installed a booth in the same IFA-NEXT area as METI and drew about 150 visitors, including people interested in the standard. We also gave lectures to introduce the latest ECHONET activities.
- At the exhibition at IFA / NEXT, ECHONET Consortium will appeal the high value of ECHONET specification data in the future data distribution society, and will work with international standardization organizations to ensure consistency between standard data We will promote activities.
- •We also appealed internationally that the ECHONET spesification is "wide" (many models), "deep" (extensive properties), and "safe" (AIF certification).
